Comprehensive Articulation Agreement

Students who began at a North Carolina community college fall of 1997 or later, who plan to transfer with an A.A., A.S. or A.F.A and who follow the common curriculum as outlined by your community college, will satisfy the freshman/sophomore requirements for our university general education requirements, other than our foreign language and physical education requirements. Each course within the core must be completed with a grade of C or higher.

Students who do not meet the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA) should use the attached course recommendations to meet UNC Asheville's general education requirements.

The following students will not satisfy the CAA general education core:

- ~Students who began at a community college before fall semester 1997
- ~Students who transfer courses from another institution (not a North Carolina Community College) into the community college.
- ~Students who do not complete the 44 hour general education core as defined by the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement: each course within the core must be completed with a grade of C or higher.

If you graduated high school Spring 1988 or after, and did not complete the minimum course requirements for the University of North Carolina system, you are required to complete the 24 semester hours listed below at a NC Community College for application to the University of North Carolina at Asheville.

Students need to *complete a minimum* of 6 college transferrable semester hours in each of the following subjects, with a grade of "C" or better (total of 24 semester hours): **English, Mathematics, Natural Science, Social Science**

PLEASE NOTE*

1. We do not accept technical or vocational credit.
2. We do not accept courses for which a student has received **D or F** grades, and do not accept courses which are below college level. Refer to list of acceptable courses.
3. Proficiency credit, placement credit, or credit by examination does not transfer.
4. If you had more than 60 semester hours from a two-year school, we list all hours acceptable, but you will have to complete a minimum of 60 semester hours at a four-year school, thus increasing total hours to graduate to more than 120. Once you have earned 60 hours (at all schools combined) you may not earn additional credit at a two-year school.
5. If you take courses at a two year school after receiving a four year degree, no credit will be awarded for those courses.
6. Courses taken at a two-year school will not count towards the 30 semester hours needed at the 300-400 level towards graduation, although they may have fulfilled a 300 level requirement.
7. Students who have completed an Associates Degree and/or the 44 hour core are still responsible for completing the following upper level General Education requirements at UNC Asheville; Humanities 324, 414, ARTS 310. UNCA also requires 6 semester hours of Foreign Language, 1 semester hour of Physical Activity, and 1-3 semester hours of Health and Wellness for General Education (please refer to attached General Education Recommendation sheet for course equivalencies which can be completed at a NC Community College).
8. CLEP examinations are accepted. However, General Exams must be taken prior to admission, or no later than 1st semester of residence in any institution. Subject examinations may be taken at any time during a student's enrollment.
9. Major equivalencies are determined by the major department after you have officially declared a major through the major department. Students must complete at least one-half of the major at UNCA if a transfer student.
10. Transferability and application of courses within this document may change without notification.
